To be eligible, you must be:

- ✓ 18–24 years of age
- ✓ Town of Hempstead / City of Long Beach Resident
- ✓ Not currently attending high school or college and one of the following:
  - A school dropout
  - A High School graduate who is economically disadvantaged and either deficient in reading and/or math, or an English language learner
  - An individual who has been involved with the juvenile or adult justice system
  - A homeless individual
  - A foster child
  - An individual who is pregnant or parenting
  - An individual with a disability
  - An economically disadvantaged individual who requires our assistance
